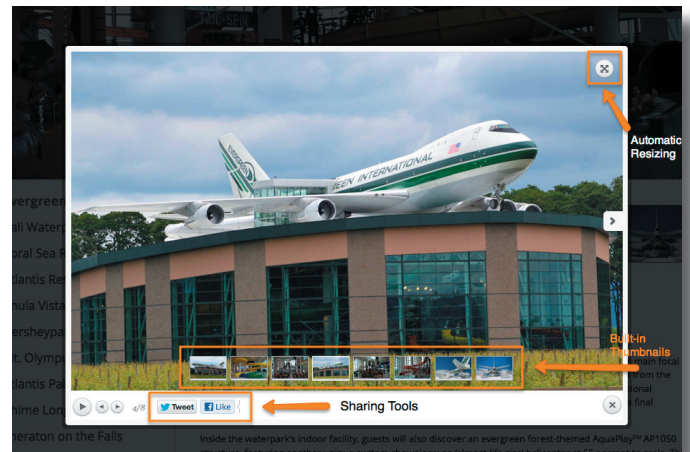
JGallery
Added a new gallery type called Lightbox. Supports photos and videos (hosted on your site or on YouTube). Also comes with built-in sharing tools.

Payments
Updates include a new refund tool, more administrator check-out features and the addition of a statement of sale. Users also now have the option of paying a specific invoice instead of the full account balance.

Job Postings
Added the capability of accepting payments when someone wants a job posted on your site.

Report Builder
We improved on the interface and made the “add conditions” screen more intuitive.

Added the capability of selecting multiple recipient groups.



JGallery - new Lightbox gallery with social networking tools, built-in thumbnails and automatic resizing. Supports photos and videos.

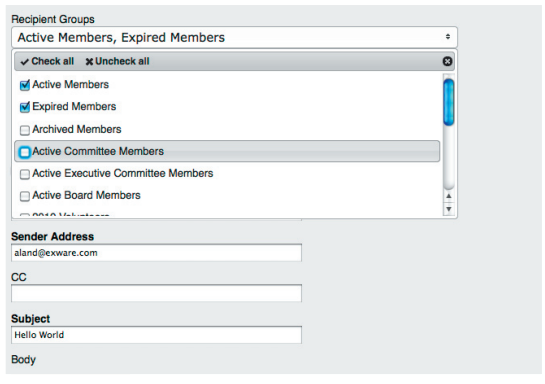
