- Our HTML Editor has now been upgraded to the latest version of TinyMCE, making it easier to use and giving it a cleaner look

- Easily move a document or file from one library to another (click on 'edit' icon beside your file)

EMAIL DISTRIBUTION

- New and improved "recipients" selector
- Scheduled emails - approximate time can now be selected
- Improved scheduling - the scheduling of emails is now simpler to use and accomodates time zones
- For Canadian clients - "CASL Smart" features now available

Now allows for easy creation of galleries and will place them on pages for you

- More checkout help options

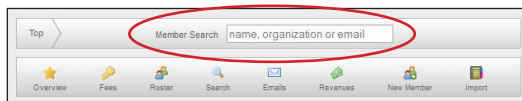

- We've added a new Search box to the Membership Module menu bar for quick access to member profiles



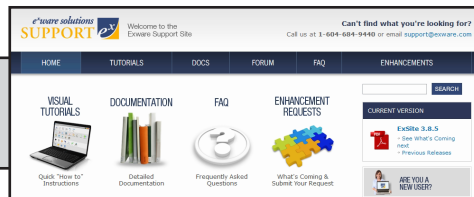
- Admins can now send emails directly from Membership, Report Builder, and Event Reg modules

ADDING EMAIL ADDRESSES TO WEB PAGES

When using the 'mailto', if you enter the email address in the parameters field, it shows up as the email address. If you want a word to be the mailto link (ie., EMAIL), you must enter it as follows in the parameter field:

test@exware.com,EMAIL
